Dear NFTY-SAR LLTI Participants and Parents,

I hope everyone is looking forward to [LLTI!](#) We will be spending next weekend (August 24-26) together as one community at URJ Camp Coleman in Cleveland, GA. The Regional Board and I have been working extremely hard to plan an amazing weekend for all of you! Below is some important information that will be helpful for you to get ready for LLTI. Please read the following very carefully:

Networks & Electives

Most of the programming at LLTI is focused on leadership training. Some of the training is done in networks where you're with the same network for 2 sessions, and some is done as electives where you choose a different topic for each session.

For those teens that hold positions on their youth group board that correspond to our regional board members (President, PVP, SAVP, RCVP, MVP, and CVP), you will spend several hours during the weekend learning with your network of people who hold the same position. If your TYG has different positions, or a general board, or if you're coming to LLTI to learn more general leadership skills, you have the option of either choosing the network that best fits your leadership interests, or attending our "General Leadership" network.

Drop-off and Pick-up

Participants will be able to check-in starting a 5pm on Friday, August 24th. All cars and buses should drop off teens at the URJ Camp Coleman Dining Hall (201 Camp Coleman Drive Cleveland, GA 30528). [Get directions to URJ Camp Coleman](#).

Check-in is from 5pm-6pm. **Please do not arrive before 5pm.** Please email nftysar@urj.org if you are expecting to arrive at the event later than 6:30 pm. All participants should make

arrangements to be picked up/depart at 10:00am on Sunday, August 26th from URJ Camp Coleman. All teens must be picked up and dropped off by an adult. If you will be picked up early from the event, please email nftysar@uri.org. **Please remember that no NFTY-ites are allowed to drive to, from or during the event.**

Dress Code

- The dress code for most of the weekend is CAMP CASUAL. Jeans/shorts and t-shirts are appropriate for most activities, including services.
 - We strongly recommend you wear close-toed shoes the entire weekend. Flip-flops and sandals can lead to injuries!
 - **The theme for Saturday night's social is "Out of this World"** – please bring your best, most creative "Out of this World" outfit!
 - Pack a sweatshirt and/or jacket for night time, as it may be chilly at night. Please [check the anticipated weather](#). We will be outside for much of the weekend so please dress appropriately for the weather. Definitely pack rain gear!

Housing

All LLTI participants and adults will be housed in cabins/camp housing. All cabins have inside bathroom/shower facilities. You will find out on Friday who else is in your cabin. Each cabin will have one adult housed with the teens. If you made a housing request, every attempt was made to honor at least one of your requests. Please know that these are a REQUEST and not a guarantee. If you did not make any housing requests, you will be housed with other same-gender teens in your grade level.

Packing Checklist

- The pool will be open during free time – **bring a bathing suit and beach towel!**
- You may get wet/dirty during one program, so **bring an extra change of clothes!**
- For the Saturday night social, bring an outfit that is **out of this world!**
- CAMP CASUAL for Friday, Saturday and Sunday - [check the weather](#)
- Close-toed shoes strongly recommended all weekend (required for some activities)
- Raincoat or Poncho - just in case it rains
- Flashlight, Water Bottle, Sunscreen, Camera (optional)
- Tzedakah Item (school supplies)
- Personal Toiletries and Flip Flops for the Shower (optional)
- **Sheets/Blanket and/or Sleeping Bag**
- **Pillow/Pillowcase**
- **Towel**
- **Your NFTY-SAR Lanyard (if you have one) or \$1 to purchase (optional)**
- Extra spending money (The registration fee covers all meals, housing, and programs for the entire weekend). There is a NFTY-SAR Shuk (store) selling t-shirts and other merchandise.

Being that we live in a technology driven society, I understand the importance or convenience of having cell phones, digital cameras, ipods, and other pocket electronics. Although these items are not prohibited at NFTY-SAR events, I want to be clear that NFTY-SAR/URJ and its employees and URJ Camp Coleman are not responsible for any lost or misplaced items. You will not be allowed to use cell phones for calls or text messages during any programming. If you need to make a call during the event, you must get permission from your TYG advisor or the Regional Advisor.

Shuk

We will have NFTY-SAR merchandise available for purchase at the Shuk during LLTI. The cost of these items will range from \$2 to \$25 an item. Bring cash so that you can purchase these must-have NFTY items!

Cancellations

There will be no refunds for cancellations the week of the event or no shows the day of the
